Protocol for sport event organiser bodies for the development of sustainable sport events

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The Green Games project (ID: 1011810448), an Erasmus+ initiative co-funded by the European Union, is seeking experts in the implementation of policies and strategies for sustainable sport events for the creation of a protocol for green sport events.

About the project

Green Games is a project focused on promoting sustainability and learning mobility in European sports events. Our goals include:

1. To raise awareness of the importance of sustainability promotion, and sustainable strategies and policies in sport events, contributing to the green transformation of the sport sector.
2. To evaluate the level of implementation of sustainability strategies in European sports events and collect good practices.
3. To provide sport event organiser bodies with knowledge on how to implement policies and strategies for sustainable sport events through the creation of a protocol for green sport events.
4. To recognise sports events that are committed to sustainability by creating a new quality "Green Game Seal" to award compliance with the Protocol in the adoption and promotion of sustainable measures and behaviours in sports events, as well as to certify as many of them as possible meeting the quality requirements.
5. To disseminate and foster the exchange of best practices and recommendations for green sport events through a green sport event network.
6. To promote sports events as models for the green transition of events in other sectors and contribute to the sport sector's role in advancing the Sustainable Development Goals.

Expert Contributions Sought

We are looking for experienced professionals in the following areas to provide feedback in the drafting process of the protocol for green sport events:

- Expertise in sports event organisation.
- Expertise in sustainability applied to sports events.
- Experience working within sports organisations in event management or sustainability.
- Experience working with local authorities or public bodies involved in hosting sport events
- Experience in sustainable procurement, logistics, or mobility related to sport events
- Academic or applied research expertise in sport management or sport event sustainability.
- Different stakeholders involved in the sustainability area ex: Deloitte,
- NGOs activating in the targeted area. Ex: Terres des Hommes

Key Responsibilities

Selected experts will contribute to:

- Defining the scope of the Protocol and its key points: Work collaboratively to outline and establish key elements of the protocol, which will serve as a framework for event organisers.
- Suggest indicators, benchmarks, or good practices relevant to specific sustainability areas
- Defining the criteria for the call for accreditation: Recommend key elements to analyse for sports events to be granted accreditation.
- Identify potential risks, limitations, or implementation challenges for sport event organisers
- Validating the final Protocol: Participate in an online session to refine and validate the final Protocol.



Application Process

To apply, please submit a CV and a cover letter detailing your relevant experience and specific areas of expertise related to event management and/or sustainability by March 25th, 2026. Selected experts will work in close collaboration with the Green Games consortium and will be acknowledged on the final deliverable that will be submitted to the European Commission.

There is no remuneration provided. The involvement of the experts will be limited to providing feedback and serving as a sounding board for the drafters.
